**E**uropean **E**mployment **S**ervices is a cooperation network of the public employment services of the European Community and the EFTA States. The network is coordinated by the European Commission. Thanks to the Agreement on the Free Movement of Persons, Switzerland is also a member of EURES.

### Objective

The EURES network promotes the cross-border mobility of workers within the European Economic Area.

### EURES Switzerland

The State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) organises and coordinates the Swiss EURES network.

**Border partnerships** exist between the border cantons and the neighbouring countries of Austria, France, Germany, Italy, and the Principality of Liechtenstein. These partnerships offer counselling services responsive to citizens' concerns.

- Special assistance with respect to cross-border regions (border partnerships)
- Job placement

#### ... and for employers

- Support in recruiting workers from the EU/EFTA States
- Advice on foreign postings of employees to and from Switzerland
